

Projected Long-term Outcome: All residents of Las Animas and Huerfano Counties have access to safe, accessible, convenient, and affordable local and regional transit services.






- SCCOG Transit provides demand-response public transportation within Las Animas and Huerfano Counties (outlying areas may be limited to coordinated routes)
- ADA Accessible vans and shuttles
- Regional service to Pueblo three days a week
- Regional service between Trinidad and Walsenburg three days week
- Pre-scheduled door to door transportation (at least 24 hours notice)
- Rides to work, shopping, medical appointments or other errands
- Affordable Fares and we accept Medicaid approved rides
- Those over 60 and registered with the SCCOG AAA ride free!




EARLY LEARNING CENTER

- Early Learning Center program is offered to all families regardless of family income. Colorado Child Care Assistance Program accepted.
- Hours of operation 7:30 am to 5:30 pm Monday through Friday in a year round comprehensive program
- High Proficiency scores of young children prior to kindergarten in the areas of Social Emotional, Physical, Language, Cognitive Literacy and Early Mathematics through the State of Colorado's Results Matter on line assessment.
- 98% proficiency rates on the Colorado Pre School Program Results Matter State Assessment.
